



Aloha, I am writing in strong support of HB 257, which would allow Ohana Zones. Currently, Ohana Zones must be located on state or county land, which makes it difficult for rural areas to find efficient solutions for homelessness, especially in rural areas. This means that private landowners who want to help end homelessness could be penalized. For example, Sacred Heart Shelter (the Pāhoā micro-housing project) for lava victims on privately held land, could be turned into an Ohana Zone and provide much needed homelessness resources for the Puna community. Therefore, I strongly support HB 257.






